

ExecuJet Berlin FIFTH ANNIVERSARY

ExecuJet Europe celebrated the fifth anniversary of its Berlin Schönefeld FBO in October. The facility is now handling around 3,000 movements a year. Aircraft visiting have been as large as the Boeing BBJ, Airbus Corporate Jet and Boeing 767. The ExecuJet Berlin Schönefeld facility is now home to an expanded 25 dedicated personnel, providing fast and exclusive VIP passenger handling for all arriving and departing business aircraft. “We successfully won the bid in January 2010 to manage the airport’s General Aviation terminal (GAT) and again earlier this year we were proud to receive the Shell Gold

Service Award, which recognizes the high standards of safety and security that we provide at ExecuJet for both our passengers and visiting flight crew, said Nicole Gut, ExecuJet European FBO Director.”

ExecuJet is the only full service FBO at Berlin Schönefeld, offering a host of amenities and facilities. These include a VIP passenger lounge and conference room, a crew lounge and briefing room, towing, lavatory and

water services, catering, fuel supply, as well as landing and overflight permits. A limousine transfer service was introduced this summer to aid swift transfers to the city and beyond. ExecuJet regularly supports incentive and event travel and it has secured deals with several leading hotels in the region. ExecuJet is the only aviation company based on the general aviation ramp with its own fuel trucks (Shell has two trucks

positioned at the business aviation facility) and five ramp personnel able to provide refueling services, which affords valuable time saving benefits to business aviation customers. The GAT lobby underwent a light refurbishment this summer, which saw its lounge enhanced. ExecuJet has also enjoyed a long-standing relationship with maintenance provider LBAS at Schönefeld Airport.
